Dear Parents/Carers,

As part of our Learning Journey - 'Gunpowder, Treason and Plot'- next half term, we will be taking the children to the Tower of London.

Children will learn more about the Tower's role as a prison and they will go through the events leading up to, and following, Guy Fawkes' imprisonment.

Details are as follows:

Date: Tuesday 19th November 2024

Departure: 8.50am **Return:** 3.30 pm

Place: Tower of London

London, EC3N 4AB

Travel: Bus, overground and underground train

Cost: A voluntary contribution of **£8** is needed to cover the cost of the trip.

Unfortunately, without sufficient uptake, the sessions will not take place.

The children will need a **packed lunch**, **water bottle (both to be packed in a backpack)** and comfortable **walking shoes** (preferably trainers). The children need to **wear school uniform** and a **jacket** with a hood advised in the event of rainy weather.

If you require the school to provide a packed lunch, please let us know 2 weeks in advance of the trip.
